Trip Itinerary

Day 1. Chengdu to Four Sisters

Meet your bus this morning across from Jinli St at 6:45am to begin your journey to Paradise. As you head out of the Sichuan basin you pass through a virtual time warp where everything becomes new: landscape, climate, cuisine, language, customs, and of course, the people. Ascending to terraced heights, you will travel through bamboo forests, quaint mountain communities, and beautiful canyon valleys. Arriving at your modern accommodations by the afternoon leaves you with plenty of time to enjoy the wonders of the Changping Valley and Siguniangshan National Park. Changping Valley itself is outfitted with boardwalks which makes for an easier walk considering the altitude. Relax as you take in the clean air and breathtaking scenery. City life feels like another world away by this point.

Day 2. Four Sisters.

After breakfast, today you will head out for a full day to explore the Haizi Valley. Today's trek will take you up the ridge for beautiful views of the Four Sisters Range (max elevation of 3850m). This area is renowned for its natural beauty, alpine views, numerous waterfalls, and diverse landforms, flora, and fauna. This is the perfect day for anyone. Enjoy a picnic lunch; take a nap under a tree; play games with your kids in the grasslands on the broad ridge; linger along the trail and photograph everything you see; or push your limits to explore the reaches of the valley. Our guides will accommodate all of the above. Return earlier in the afternoon to relax at the guesthouse, or come back down in time for dinner at the end of the day. We'll do our best to help make it your day.
